A Customer Service Inspection is required on:

- a) new service;
- b) established service where there is construction;
- c) established service that has been transferred from one member to another; or,
- d) any service on which a cross connection is suspected.

The member may elect to have Corporation personnel perform the inspection on **a**, **b**, or **c** for a **\$75.00 fee**; or, an independent contractor who sets his/her own fees may do the inspection in the time frame specified by the Corporation. In the case of a suspected cross connection, Corporation personnel will perform the inspection for **a \$75.00 fee**, **payable in advance**.

Grievance Procedure (MSWSC Tariff, Section B.9)

Any Member of the Corporation or individual demonstrating an interest under the policies of this Tariff in becoming a member of the Corporation shall have an opportunity to voice concerns or grievances to the Corporation by the following means and procedures:

- a) By presentation of concerns to the Corporation's Manager or authorized staff member. If not resolved to the satisfaction of the aggrieved party, then
- b) By presenting a letter to the Board of Directors stating the individual's grievance or concern and the desired result.
- c) The Board of Directors shall respond to the complaint by communicating the Board's decision in writing.
- d) Any charges or fees contested as a part of the complaint in review by the Corporation under this policy shall be suspended until a satisfactory and final decision has been made by the Board of Directors.
